

DECEMBER 30, 2010 - Maplewood Street Fire

Firefighters responded to a report of smoke near the Catholic Church at 4:05 PM on Dec. 30th. Engine 692 crew gave an on-scene report of a fully involved shed fire located behind a historic residence at 35 Maplewood Street. Engines 691 and 693 also responded, including Battalion 691. Firefighter efforts were primarily focused on protecting nearby structures. The shed and contents were a total loss. No other property damages occurred and no injuries were reported.
